

LANGUAGECERT International Spoken ESOL Achiever level – B1 Paper 1 – 2016

Interlocutor's instructions

CHECK THAT THE RECORDER IS ON AND WORKING

Test time: 12 minutes

I = Interlocutor C = Candidate

PART 1 (3 minutes)

I: LANGUAGECERT International Spoken ESOL Exam, Achiever level, (give today's date).

(NB This introduction only needs to be recorded before the first candidate's test begins, not for subsequent candidates.)

(Give candidate's name.) Exam begins. Hello. My name's (give full name). Can you spell your family name for me, please?

- C: (Spells family name.)
- I: Thank you. Which country are you from?
- C: (Responds.)
- I: Thank you. Now, Part One. I'm going to ask you some questions about yourself. (Choose **up to five** questions, one from each of the different topic areas, as time allows. Name the topic; eg 'Now, **Watching Films**.')

Topics

Watching films

- What was the last film you watched?
- Are there any kinds of film you don't like watching? Why?

Languages

- Which languages can you speak?
- Which country would you like to visit and learn their language?

Health and fitness

- How often do you take physical exercise?
- How can schools help students to keep fit and healthy?

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Making things

- Have you made anything useful or decorative for your home?
- What things did you learn to make in your first years at school?

Playing games

- Which games did you use to play when you were little?
- What do you think about computer games?

C: (Responds.)

1: (Interlocutor makes **brief** responses and/or comments.)

I: Thank you.

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PART 2 (3 minutes)

I: Now, Part Two. We are going to role-play some situations. I want you to start or respond. First situation (choose one situation from **A**).

Α

- I'm a teacher visiting your school. I start.

 Could you tell me where I can find the Director's office please?
- We're at a science museum. I start.

 We've got about an hour. What shall we look at first?
- C: (Responds.)
- 1: (Role-play the situation with the candidate approximately two turns each.)
- I: Second situation (choose one situation from **B**).


- I'm a waiter in a cafe. You are not happy with the food I've given you. You start.
- I'm your friend. I've been waiting for you for twenty minutes. You start.
- C: (Initiates.)
- 1: (Role-play the situation with the candidate approximately two turns each.)
- 1: (Role-play a third situation from **A** or **B** if time allows.)
- I: Thank you.

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PART 3 (3 minutes)

I: Now, Part Three. We're going to discuss something together.
Our class is presenting a project called 'Communicating in the 21st Century.' We are designing a poster to advertise the presentation.

Let's ask and answer questions to help us make some decisions. (Hand over candidate's task sheet.) I'll start.



I: Thank you. [Retrieve candidate's task sheet.]

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PART 4 (3 minutes including follow-up questions)

I: In Part Four you are going to talk about something for one and a half minutes. Your topic is (choose topic for candidate).

Topics

- A A sports event you would like to go to
- B Your favourite holiday place
- I: You now have thirty seconds to write some notes to help you. (Hand over piece of paper and pen/pencil.) So your topic is (repeat topic). (Withdraw eye contact for thirty seconds. Leave recorder running.)
- I: (Candidate's name), please start.
- C: (Talks.)
- I: (When candidate has talked for a maximum of one and a half minutes, say, 'Thank you', and then ask some follow-up questions.)

Follow-up questions

A sports event you would like to go to

- Who would you like to go to the sports event with?
- Do you prefer to watch sports live or on TV? Why?
- What new sport would you like to try?
- Are there any sports you really don't like watching? Why?

Your favourite holiday place

- What would it be like to live in that place all the time?
- Which other places would you like to go to for holidays?
- Do you think that place will change in the future?
- What kind of holiday place would you **not** enjoy? Why?
- I: Thank you. (Give candidate's name.) That is the end of the exam.
